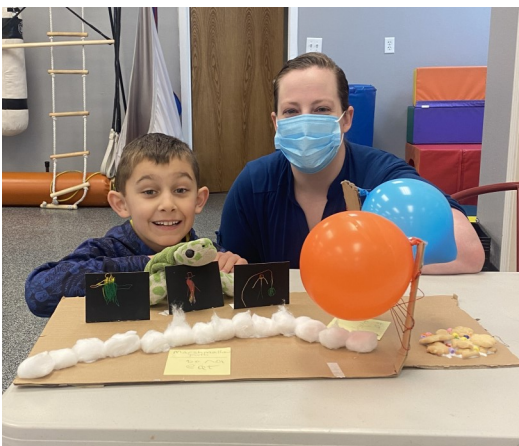
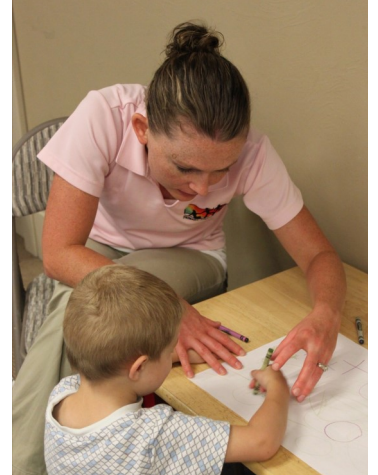


Our Occupational Therapy staff at Primary Therapy Source is committed to facilitating growth and love so that clients and families feel empowered to engage in meaningful occupations.
